Latest land release in Annadale

The Annadale community is taking shape, with most of the current releases now sold out.

There are, however, a number of exclusive parkland lots still available in the Hawksbury, Picton and Apsley land releases.

Available lots are located in the heart of the community with easy access to the connected walking and cycling trails sprawled throughout Mount Ridley Conservation Reserve. Interested buyers should move quickly as this is an opportunity not to be missed.



Progress Update at Annadale

The Annadale community is now well established and construction of remaining Stages is progressing smoothly.

Stage 17 is nearing completion with construction of footpaths and driveways due to be finished before the end of June.

Stage 18 is also progressing well. The construction of kerb and channel, electrical works and installation of the NBN is all complete. Asphalt is due to be laid on the roadway in early July.

Gas and water installation are complete in Stage 20, with construction of the road way set to begin in early July.

Earthworks in Stage 12B are complete and works on the underground drainage network is set to be finished soon after.

Construction works on Stage 21 are set to begin shortly, with final approval from Hume City Council expected to be received in the coming weeks.
